Overview

We Great Panorama Treks and Expedition (P).Ltd here offers you Naya Khang Peak Climbing This peak is a less popular climbing peak and is climbed by fewer climbers in Nepal. The altitude of the Naya Khang Peak is 5800m. The peak is also known as Ganja La and is one of the popular trekking peaks in Nepal. This peak is the nearest peak to Kathmandu. It lies 19 miles or 30 km north of Kathmandu valley to Langtang region. It is suited for beginner climbers due to its nontechnical geographical structure. Everyone who has trekking experience and good physical fitness can climb the peak. The classical trek combines three major areas along the border of Tibet, Langtang, Helambu, and Gosainkunda Lake. Since the Nayakhang peak includes Helambu valley you can view the beautiful scenery of nature Helambu valley is very famous for its natural beauty and wonderful climate with superb views of magnificent snow-covered mountains. Many people make a plan after



this peak climb they go continue the Helambu Sherpa valley trek after crossing the Ganjala pass which is also difficult even after climbing the peak for all. The best season for this all September to November and March to May which is the best season for know in Nepal trek and expedition.

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Details Day Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival at Katmandu

Arrive at the Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu, and meet our company representative. From there, they will transfer you to your hotel. During the evening, you can take a quick stroll around your hotel. Or, you can just rest as there are no activities planned for today besides your arrival. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 2

Trek Preparation

Today, we shall head on a tour to explore the major UNESCO World Heritage Sites of the Kathmandu valley. We will visit sites such as Kathmandu Durbar Square, Pashupatinath, Boudhanath, and Swayambhunath. After visiting these sites, head back to your hotel and complete all the necessary paperwork needed for the trip ahead. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 3

Drive to Dhunche 150km (6-7 hours)

Drive to Dhunche 150km (6-7 hours) We shall wake up early and drive away from the hustling Kathmandu to Dhunche. The drive takes us about 7 hours and it goes through pitch as well as



graveled roads. Dhunche is the district headquarters of Rasuwa District and you will find many tourists here who are on the road to Langtang. Overnight in Dhunche.

Day 4

Trek to Thulo Syabru (5-6 hours)

From Dhunche, we shall head on an initially gradually descending trail to Thulo Syabru. We walk on the foothills of Syabru and, along the way, we can see Ganesh Himal (7,422m) and Langtang Mountain. We shall be accompanied by the Trishuli River as well. After a steep climb up to Bharkhu, you continue climbing steadily up to Thulo Syabru. It is a resting point for many trekkers on this route. Overnight in Thulo Syabru.

Day 5

Trek to Lama Hotel (6-7 hours)

Trek to Lama Hotel (6-7 hours) The trail for today takes us across the Bhote Koshi River and into the banks of the Langtang River. Our destination for today is the Lama hotel which is basically a group of small lodges in the middle of wilderness. The trail goes through Bamboo gradually ascending and, later, the rugged terrain takes us to Rimche. Have lunch there and head towards the Lama Hotel. Overnight in Lama Hotel.

Day 6

Trek to Langtang Village (5 ½ hours)

The trail from Lama Hotel to the Langtang village goes uphill through Gumnachowk and stops at Ghodatabela. You can see yaks and horses carrying numerous goods on the way. Walk through a dusty trail and you will arrive at the Langtang village. This is an ancient village and the residents



here mostly follow Buddhism. Spend your time here interacting with the locals and learning about their lifestyle, religion, and culture. Overnight in Langtang village.

Day 7

Trek to Kyanjin Gompa (4 ½ hours)

Our destination today is one of the major attractions of this trip, Kyanjin Gompa. It is the most sacred monastery in the region. Along the way, we get great view of Langtang Lirung (7,227m). We shall also visit the cheese factory famous for yak cheese. Once you arrive in Kyanjin Gompa, visit the monastery to observe and learn about Buddhism from the monks. From here, you'll also marvel at the sight of the glorious Langtang Lirung (7,227m) and Ganchempo (6,388m). Overnight in Kyanjin Gompa.

Day 8

Rest for Excursion to around Kyanjin Gompa

Today, we shall embark on a journey to explore the outskirts of the Kyanjin Gompa. We will hike to the summit of Tserko Ri (4,984m) and find ourselves in front of the magnificent allure of mountains like Langtang (7,227m), Dorje Lakpa (6966m), and Ganchempo (6,388m). Further interact with the monks in the monastery to understand their way of life and have some yak cheese as well. Overnight in Kyanjin Gompa.

Day 9

Trek to Naya Khang Base Camp (5-6 hours)

The objective for the day is to reach the Naya Khang Base Camp. To reach there, we must continue on an uphill trail and go through birch and coniferous forests, and later, along the Langtang River. We shall continue our climb until we arrive at the base camp. Depending on the time of the year,



you'll find the base camp covered in snow or yaks grazing. Overnight in tents in Base Camp.

Day 10

Trek to High Camp (4-5 hours)

Leaving the base camp, we head to the High Camp today getting closer to the summit of Naya Khang Peak. The trail is a steep climb up to the High Camp. The trek is short today which will work in our favor as the altitude is high and only getting higher. The climb may require the need of trekking equipment. We need to cross the snow-laden paths and avalanche prone parts as well. Overnight in High camp.

Day 11

Reserve day at High Camp

Today is a day or contingency in the high camp. To prepare ourselves for the final climb, we shall spend a day in the high camp, and learn about the proper usage of climbing equipment and learn some tips and tricks from the head guide. Be sure to take full rest as we have a big day tomorrow. Overnight in High Camp.

Day 12

Early morning Climb to Naya Khang Peak summit Back to Base camp overnight at Tent

The timing of the climb shall depend on the weather conditions and our head guide. The climb to the top involves crossing snowy terrain and strong winds. Initially, the climb is gradually through boulders and snow. Towards the end, the trail gets steep with lots of snow and some ice that might require slow and careful climb. From the summit, we get spectacular view of Langtang, Gaurishankar, Ganesh, and Dorje Lakpa ranges, and Langtang Valley. After conquering the summit, we slowly head back to the base camp. Overnight in base camp.



Day 13

Trek Down to Kyanjin Gompa (4-5 hours)

From the base camp, we head back to Kyanjin Gompa. We shall use the same trail that we had used before on the ascent. Today, we have to do a lot of descending which might get a little hard on your knees. The walk sees the landscape transcend from snow and rocks to lush valleys and forest. Overnight in Kyanjin Gompa.

Day 14

Trek Down to Lama Hotel (6-7 hours)

The backward journey continues today. We will head back to the Lama hotel. We shall follow the Langtang River and observe the landscape filled with flowers and trees. Lama hotel is a group of lodges in the middle of a forest. Upon arrival, you can explore the nearby areas around the hotel. Overnight in Lama Hotel.

Day 15

Trek Down to Syabrubensi (6-7 hours)

The trip is nearing its end. From Lama Hotel, we shall further descend down to the small settlements of Bamboo and Rimche. We have our lunch in Rimche and continue the journey until we arrive at Syabrubensi. The Langtang River will keep us company until we reach Syabrubensi. Overnight in Syabrubensi.



Day 16

Drive Back to Kathmandu (170km) 7/8 hours | Farewell Dinner

The trip is coming to an end today. We shall catch a bus to Kathmandu and embark on an 8-hour long journey. The roads are filled with treacherous curves and but the view of the hills, rivers and rural settlements will give you enjoyment throughout. Upon arrival in Kathmandu, transfer to your hotel. At night, the company will host you a farewell dinner for a successful completion of the climb. At the time of registration, Trekker's are expected to pay a deposit 30% of total cost to complete your booking. Please note the trip cost is required to make in advance as per the company policy, this deposit help us to make confirm reservation of Hotels in City, domestic flights and all other trip arrangements for final trip booking. Along with deposit we need detailed name lists of participants, same as passport, Gender, Nationality, Date of birth, passport number, passport issue/ Expiry dates &



profession. You need to send us passport copy, photo identity and e-ticket by e-mail for all trips in Nepal.

Cancellation Policy: If any reason you have to cancel your trip, we Unique Sherpa Trek and expedition require written confirmation of your decision. The amount you have paid to us will be refunded according to the following terms:

- Cancellation more than 35 days before your departure date: \$60 will charged.
- Cancellation more than 35 to 19 days before your departure date: your deposit, 25% will charged.
- Cancellation more than 18 to 10 days before your departure date: 50% will charged.
- Cancellation more than 9 to 05 days before your departure date: 75% will charged.
- Cancellation less than 4 days before your departure date: 100% of the total will charged.

In case of cancellation before trip or after trip the accommodation and food cost need to bear by yourself.

In case of incomplete treks or tour: No refund will be made to clients who drop out from the journey regardless of whatever portions remain unused in the itinerary. First of all, we never broke the trekking team in between until our last destination as per our itinerary given to you.
